## MATERIALS:

[1] AMASH Panel

1 yard Blender Red, includes binding

1/2 yard Blender Blue

3/4 yard Blender Navy, includes binding

1/4 yard Stars Navy

1/4 yard Stars Red

1/4 yard Circle Stars Blue

1/4 yard Circle Stars Red

1/4 yard Banners Red

1/4 yard Fireworks Navy

2 yards fabric of choice for backing (45" wide)

*BEFORE SEWING, READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS.  
ALL SEAMS ARE 1/4" UNLESS OTHERWISE  
STATED. LABEL THE CUTS AS YOU GO.  
WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; LOF = LENGTH  
OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER*

## CUTTING:

### From AMASH Panel:

Fussy cut [6] — 10-1/2" squares around motifs

### From Blender Red Fabric:

Cut [3] — 2-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut [40] — 2-3/4" squares **(A)**

Cut [2] — 1-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [4] — 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles **(B)**

Cut [7] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips, binding

### From Blender Blue Fabric:

Cut [3] — 2-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut [40] — 2-3/4" squares **(C)**

Cut [2] — 1-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [4] — 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles **(D)**

### From Blender Navy Fabric:

Cut [3] — 2-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut [40] — 2-3/4" squares **(E)**

Cut [2] — 1-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [4] — 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles **(F)**

Cut [4] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips, binding

### From Circle Stars Blue Fabric:

Cut [1] — 4-3/4" × WOF strip

Subcut [10] — 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangles **(G)**

### From Fireworks Navy Fabric:

Cut [1] — 4-3/4" × WOF strip

Subcut [10] — 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangles **(H)**

### From Stars Navy Fabric:

Cut [1] — 4-3/4" × WOF strip

Subcut [10] — 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangles **(I)**

### From Circle Stars Fabric:

Cut [1] — 4-3/4" × WOF strip

Subcut [10] — 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangles **(J)**

### From Banners Red Fabric:

Cut [1] — 4-3/4" × WOF strip

Subcut [10] — 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangles **(K)**

### From Stars Red Fabric:

Cut [1] — 4-3/4" × WOF strip

Subcut [10] — 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangles **(L)**

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

### Flying Geese Block

Make [10] Blender Red / Circle Stars Blue flying geese blocks. **(M)**

For each Blender Red / Circle Stars Blue flying geese block, you will need:

[2] Blender Red 2-3/4" squares **(A)**

[1] Circle Stars Blue 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangle **(G)**

1. Mark a diagonal line on the back of the [2] Blender Red 2-3/4" squares **(A)**.



2. Place [1] Blender Red 2-3/4" square **(A)** RST with the Circle Stars Blue 2-3/4" × 4-3/4" rectangle **(G)**, as shown.



3. Stitch on the line.



4. Press the Blender Red triangle down to the lower left corner, aligning the left and bottom edges with the Circle Stars Blue rectangle **(G)**.



5. Open, and trim the seam allowance to 1/4".



6. Press the Blender Red triangle down to the lower left corner.



7. Place [1] Blender Red 2-3/4" square **(A)** RST with the Circle Stars Blue 2-3/4" x 4-3/4" rectangle **(G)**, as shown.



8. Stitch on the line.



9. Press the Blender Red triangle down to the lower right corner, aligning the right and bottom edges with the Circle Stars Blue rectangle **(G)**.



10. Open, and trim the seam allowance to 1/4".



11. Press the Blender Red triangle down to the lower right corner.



12. Trim the flying geese block to measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2". Be sure to maintain 1/4" beyond the point.

13. Repeat Steps 1-12 to make [10] Blender Red / Circle Stars Blue flying geese blocks **(M)**.

For all of the following Flying Geese, repeat steps 1-13 with the designated fabric combinations.

For each Blender Red / Fireworks Navy flying geese block **(N)**, you will need:

[2] Blender Red 2-3/4" squares **(A)**

[1] Fireworks Navy 2-3/4" x 4-3/4" rectangle **(H)**



For each Blender Blue / Stars Navy flying geese block **(O)**, you will need:

[2] Blender Blue 2-3/4" squares **(C)**

[1] Stars Navy 2-3/4" x 4-3/4" rectangle **(I)**



For each Blender Blue / Circle Stars Red flying geese block **(P)**, you will need:

[2] Blender Blue 2-3/4" squares **(C)**

[1] Circle Stars Red 2-3/4" x 4-3/4" rectangle **(J)**



For each Blender Navy / Banners Red flying geese block **(Q)**, you will need:

[2] Blender Navy 2-3/4" squares **(E)**

[1] Banners Red 2-3/4" x 4-3/4" rectangle **(K)**



For each Blender Navy / Stars Red flying geese block **(R)**, you will need:

[2] Blender Navy 2-3/4" squares **(E)**

[1] Stars Red 2-3/4" x 4-3/4" rectangle **(L)**



## PLACEMAT ASSEMBLY:

### Delaware Placemat

You will need:

[1] Delaware motif, cut from AMASH Panel

[10] Blender Red / Circle Stars Blue flying geese blocks **(M)**

[2] Blender Red 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles **(B)**



1. Sew [5] Blender Red / Circle Stars Blue flying geese blocks together in a column, as shown. Press seams down, away from the flying geese points.



2. Repeat Step 1 with the remaining [5] Blender Red / Circle Stars Blue flying geese blocks.
3. Attach [1] column of flying geese to the left and right sides of the Delaware block.



4. Attach [2] Blender Red rectangles (B) to the top and bottom of the block, as shown.



Repeat steps 1-4 as for the Delaware placemat above for each of the following [5] placements.

**Pennsylvania placemat**, you will need:

- [1] Pennsylvania Block
- [10] Blender Red / Fireworks Navy flying geese blocks (N)
- [2] Blender Red 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles (B)



**Virginia placemat**, you will need:

- [1] Virginia Block
- [10] Blender Blue / Stars Navy flying geese blocks (O)
- [2] Blender Red 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles (D)



**West Virginia placemat**, you will need:

- [1] West Virginia Block
- [10] Blender Blue / Circle Stars Red flying geese blocks (P)
- [2] Blender Blue 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles (D)



**New Jersey placemat**, you will need:

- [1] New Jersey Block
- [10] Blender Navy / Banners Red flying geese blocks (Q)
- [2] Blender Navy 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles (F)



**Maryland placemat**, you will need:

- [1] Maryland Block
- [10] Blender Navy / Stars Red flying geese blocks (R)
- [2] Blender Navy 1-1/2" × 18-1/2" rectangles (F)



## FINISHING:

1. If using a longarm, you can use one large piece of backing. If quilting on a domestic machine, cut backing to size for each placemat.
2. Sandwich backing, batting, and quilt top.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Bind as follows:  
Delaware and Pennsylvania: Bind with Blender Navy;  
Virginia, West Virginia, New Jersey, and Maryland: Bind with Blender Red.
5. Label and Enjoy!
